### Julie Evans

Julie Evans, Chief Executive Officer, Project Tomorrow will discuss the results of the *2007 Students Speak Up* data. In the past, data have been collected from students and teachers and now the collection includes parents and principals. Julie will provide a summary of Oakland County and national data so that we can learn how students, teachers and parents are using technology and what their expectations are.
