

## **Sample Transition Profile**

- **Is a legal document**
- **Started NO LATER than the 8<sup>th</sup> grade or when the student becomes fourteen**
- **Follows the student through high school**
- **Is updated yearly at IEP**
- **Priority areas appear as objectives on IEP**
- **Is passed on for use by Michigan Rehabilitation Services, Community Mental Health**

**The Transition Profile can be utilized as a means of recording and monitoring a student's progress in skills addressed within the Transition domains.**

**The Transition Profile should be started in the eighth grade or when the student becomes fourteen.**

**The best time to update the information in the student's Transition Profile would be either before or during the Individualized Transition Planning (ITP)/Individualized Education Planning (IEP) meeting or during a Parent/Teacher Conference.**

**A completed and updated Transition Profile will offer assistance to post-secondary agencies involved with ensuring transition services continue for the student following exiting school.**
